SUBJECT: Fort Jackson Policy Memorandum # 11 -- Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board Establishment Policy

1. REFERENCE: Army Regulation 190-24, Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Boards and Off-Installation Liaison and Operations, 27 July 2006.

2. PURPOSE: Establishment of Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board (AFDCB).

3. POLICY:

a. This policy is effective immediately. It remains in effect until rescinded or superseded. This policy memorandum supersedes Policy Memorandum #10 – Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board Establishment Policy, 08 August 2014.

b. The AFDCB is comprised of the following members or designated representative. Voting members are identified in **BOLD** print.


